

Agenda for RRR Rally April 16-19, Loyd Creek Park

Thursday April 16 Arrival day. **Check in time is 2pm**. When you arrive, tell the gate attendant that you are with Red River Rovers and Dean Settlemyer reservation. It will be loop A, group site. When you leave the gate, take a right and follow it all the way down until you see campsites 1-40. Drive around that loop until you see a pavilion and that will be the loop we have. There are 10 back in full hookup sites to choose from. If you get lost, call me 972-742-7511. You will only have to pay \$5.00 per day for your vehicle. If you are towing an RV, you will only have to pay for the tow vehicle. If you are pulling a vehicle behind your RV (toad) you will only have to pay for it. There may be a discount for military, just ask. The camping has already been prepaid.

Thursday evening we will be going to La Gondola as a group. The address is 1211 E Debbie Lane, Mansfield, Tx 76063. This is a really good Italian place. If you don't think you will go, just let me know ahead of time. I will call and make reservations a few days ahead of time.

Friday April 17th, Breakfast and lunch on your own. We plan on sitting under the pavilion and playing games, fellowshipping etc. For dinner, Dean and Pam will provide a taco bar. You will make your own tacos or taco salad and Dean will make his famous queso dip. Dessert will be determined later.

Saturday, April 18th, Dean and Pam and some of the men will prepare pancakes, eggs and bacon and sausage. For the afternoon, Pam has planned an outing at the Geyer Commons (www.geyercommons.com). This is a unique shopping area. After that, the women will travel over to the Painted Tree Boutiques for some more shopping. For the men, we will have an informal tech talk and do some fishing. Make sure you have your license and fishing gear. We will bank fish, so bring some good lures for bass or we can also fish for crappie. For dinner Dean and Pam will have hobo meals. You make these yourself with various meats, vegetables, spices, etc that we will provide. (You will love them). Dessert will be roasting marshmallows by the fire.

Sunday, check out time is noon. Will probably have some muffins for those that want to hang around that morning.

The pavilion is lighted and has plugs, so if it's going to be hot, you might want to bring a fan to plug in. Also don't forget your comfortable camp chairs. There are plenty of picnic tables. If you have a card table, you might want to bring one of those too because it's easier to play games on that versus a picnic table.
